### **RENT & E-BIKE**

#### VALLE ARGANTINA

## CLIMBING

#### LORETO OR ROCCA DI CORTE

A few kilometers away from Molini di Triora you can find the "Rocce di Loreto" which offer a series of small cliffs on gray limestone rocks, the "Paretone" with his spectacular routes up to 170 meters long, and the "Falesia di Corte" made up of 4 sectors close to each other made of limestone rock of excellent quality.

## PLACES TO SEE -MOLINI DI TRIORA AND SURROUNDINGS



#### SANTUARIO DELLA MADONNA DELLA MONTA'

#### MOLINI DI TRIORA

The church is located along the ancient road that connects Molini to Triora and it's dedicated to "Mary of the ascent". Tradition dates the church back to the 13th century, but the current building is from 15th century. This little church has a cycle of paintings by Antonio da Monteregale, executed in 1435, depicting the Crucifixion, the Virgin and Saints, Christ in the tomb between Saint Anthony the Abbot and Saint Biagio.



#### CASA BALESTRA MOLINI DI TRIORA

Located in the historical center of Molini di Triora, this house was part of the 23 mills where the grain produced in the mountains around Triora was processed. In 1830 this building was transformed into a civilian residence by the famous surgeon Giovanni Battista Balestra.

The house has remained as it was in the past, characterized by the typical 19th century furniture and retains evidence of scientific research and the Italian Risorgimento.



## TRIORA THE WITCHES VILLAGE

Triora is a picturesque village, well known in Italy because in the 16th century it was the place where trials and executions of witches took place - still 'commemorated' in the town museum! You will enjoy exploring the ancient alleys, arched passages and steep pathways of what is claimed to be one of the oldest villages in Liguria.



#### ANDAGNA'S TOWER ANDAGNA

Situated at 506 metres above sea level, this tower, built in sandstone blocks, is in a defensive position with two sides on a precipice on the top of a cliff. A first fortification, completely lost, apparently rose in that place already in Roman times. The current tower, dates back to a period between the 19th and 20th centuries; its structure is circular and crenellated, inside there are still traces of frescos on the ceiling with a floral theme. The charm of its ancient history certainly give importance to this magical location, where visitors can enjoy a very incredible view of the Argentina torrent and its valley.

**COLLE MELOSA** Situated at 1500mt Colle Melosa

has a nice refuge were you can enjoy a nice meal and it s a great start for different lenght walks.

**GO THE BEACH** We're only 30 minutes away from the beaches. Go for a day down the coast.









## TAGGIASCA OLIVES AND OIL

Taggiasca is a little olive that contains a high percentage of oil. It is really tasty. They say that producing Ligurian quality oil is an art, but much of the merit can be attributed to the variety of plants that, thanks to centuries of adaptation to the territory and to the climate, provide a low-acidity product with a fruity aroma and a sweet sensation. That enhances the characteristics of food without being intrusive.

## MOLINI AND TRIORA'S BREAD

Homemade mountain bread, famous due to its ingredients, whole wheat flour rich in fibers and proteins, buckwheat flour and bran, and its round and large shape, recognizable for the bran on the bottom. It can be kept for over a week, and it is very good served in slices with the bruss, a typical goat ricotta cheese, spread on them.





## BRUZZO AND LOCAL "TOMA" CHEESES

Bruzzo, or "brus" for the locals, is a typical goat ricotta cheese. Its taste is very strong, so it's good to eat it spread on a bruschetta with the local bread and fresh tomatoes. Thanks to the different breeding of goats, sheep and cows spread in the alpine meadows of the Ligurian Alps Park also different types "Toma" are produced.

### HONEY

There are different beekeeping farms in the Valley that produce excellent honey, also thanks to the extraordinary plant biodiversity and to the widespread presence of chestnut trees and mountain flowers (Rhododendron, Chestnut, Eucalyptus, Basswood, Black locust and more).





## LAVENDER

Grown naturally mainly on the sunny hills of Drego and Agaggio Superiore, many high quality products are made from the local lavender: essential oil, scents, bath and body products, but also homemade jams.

## SAFFRON

High quality Saffron, grown on the sunny hills of Triora and Glori. You can be guaranteed that this saffron has not been contaminated by chemicals or herbicides. Its delicate flavour will enhance your dishes and give them a touch of magic. Saffron is especially good when used in cooking risotto and other rice dishes.

## MUST TRY DISHES VALLE ARGENTINA AND SURROUNDINGS





## SARDENAIRA

It's similar to a pizza or a focaccia, but never call it that way! It's is garnished with home made tomato sauce, salted anchovies, local olives, garlic cloves, and capers.

## TORTA VERDE

Local savoury cake made with veggies, rice parmesan and eggs. The veggies inside change through the season, in summer is mainly Trombette (local zucchini) and in winter chard, pumpkin or artichokes.









## SNAILS

Snails are so important in Molini di Triora that they have been celebrated with a village festival for over fifty years now. They are cooked in a sauce made of herbs and local red wine and served with the local bread.

## SUGELI AL BRUZZO

A simple homemade pasta of only water and flour made into small dumplings with the typical "corpu de diu" (the appearance is similar to that of orecchiette) accompanied by a strong local cheese call "Brus", obtained from the natural fermentation of ricotta.

## FRANDURA

Simple but tasty local potato pie made with cheese, milk and marjoram herb.Traditionally is cooked in the wood oven.

## BRANDACUJUN

The recipe is made with preserved cod (stockfish with cod is generally preferred), boiled with potatoes in salted water. Once the water has drained, garlic, parsley, e.v.o. oil, Taggiasca olives, lemon juice, salt and pepper; then, once the lid has been placed on the pot, it is "brandata" or shaken vigorously until the ingredients break down and amalgamate.
